What is the 529 Jump Program?

529 Jump is a program that provides a \$50 scholarship to a qualified 529 CollegenInvest account for students in St. Vrain Valley Schools who are in kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade or 3rd grade. Each student is eligible for one scholarship. This program was created to ensure a solid jump-start to saving for their future education. The program is a partnership between St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation, the City of Longmont and CollegenInvest.



What is a 529 account?

A 529 account is a savings account that specifically helps families save for the cost of future education. There are no income requirements or restrictions to opening an account. Money is put in on a pre-tax basis, is invested to grow over time, and can then be withdrawn tax free in the future for use at any accredited institution (including colleges, trade schools, technical schools, and vocational schools). In the case that your child chooses not to seek a post secondary education, the funds can be withdrawn or transferred to another family member. The key is to get started now so the savings can grow to help lessen the burden of further education.
