**Scholarship Name:** Brendan Dunigan Memorial Foundation Scholarship

**Award:** One (1) award of \$1,000

**Background:** The Brendan Dunigan Memorial Foundation Scholarship honors Brendan Dunigan who passed from an accident on July 18, 2016. ### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Be a high school senior at a St. Vrain Valley Schools high school
- Have a 2.5 grade point average or higher
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **trade or vocational institution** beginning the fall of 2021, with the intention of ultimately completing with a program certification or license.

**Application Process:** Complete the online scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation website ([www.stvrainfoundation.org/scholarships](http://www.stvrainfoundation.org/scholarships)). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Application Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, high school, GPA, high school transcript, graduation date and name of trade or vocational school the student will be attending.
- **Financial Need** including the EFC from the FAFSA, the FAFSA SAR report and one – two paragraphs explaining the students financial aid situation or financial need.
- **Personal Essay** that is 500 words or less. The essay should describe something you have done in the past year that has made a difference in your community. Include information about how you plan to continue your involvement in your community. Also explain why you want this scholarship and how it will help your educational goals.
- **Volunteer and Community Service Record**
- **High School Honors and Awards**
- **High School Activities**
- **Leadership Positions**
- **Letters of Recommendation** to include one from a teacher, administrator or counselor and one from a community member who is not a family member.
