**Scholarship Name:** Brett Meade Scholarship for Agricultural and Animal Husbandry Studies

**Award:** One (1) award of \$1,000

**Background:** The Brett Meade Scholarship for Agricultural and Animal Husbandry Studies is provided by Pat Meade in honor of her son Brett who was very involved in agriculture in the local community. She is honoring him by providing a scholarship to support a student interested in pursuing a degree in agriculture, animal husbandry or veterinary medicine.

### **Eligibility Requirements:**

- Be a high school senior at a St. Vrain Valley Schools high school
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **two-year or four-year college, university or trade school** located in the United States, beginning the fall of 2022.
- Be planning to pursue a degree in agriculture, animal husbandry or veterinary medicine.

### **Application Process:**

**Step 1:** Complete the online scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation website ([www.stvrainfoundation.org](http://www.stvrainfoundation.org)). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Application Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, high school, GPA, high school transcript, graduation date and name of college, university or trade school the student will be attending.
- **Financial Need** including the EFC from the FAFSA, the FAFSA SAR report and one – two paragraphs explaining the students financial aid situation or financial need.
- **Volunteer and Community Service Record**
- **High School Honors and Awards**
- **High School Activities**
- **Leadership Positions**
- **Letters of Recommendation** to include one from a teacher, administrator or counselor and one from a community member who is not a family member.

**Step 2:** Complete the Brett Meade Scholarship for Agricultural and Animal Husbandry Studies application via SVVSEF scholarship platform on Kaleidoscope.

- **Personal Essay** that is 500 words or less. The essay should describe your background and future goals. Explain to the selection committee about your specific interest in and why you are planning to pursue a degree in agriculture, animal husbandry or veterinary medicine. Include pertinent aspects of your life including academic, athletic and community involvement that have shaped the direction you are planning for the future.
