Scholarship Name: Cundall Art Scholarship

Award: \$500 - \$3,000 (The amount and number of awards varies depending on funds available in the account at the time of awards)

Scholarship Sponsor: Cundall Trust Fund managed by US Bank in partnership with St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation

Eligibility Requirements:

- Graduating senior from a St. Vrain Valley Schools high school
- Demonstrate a financial need
- Submit a portfolio (See below for details)
- Students must be planning on a major or minor in Art
 - (graphic design/photography/architecture, etc.)
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at a trade/vocational institution, two-year or four-year college or university located in the United States beginning the fall of 2023.

Payable to: Payment made directly to college. Please note, scholarship payment form and thank you note must be submitted to St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation after award letter is received.

Selection committee: SVVSD Art Leadership Team

Scholarship Timeline:

- December 1, 2022: Application opens
- March 1, 2023: Application closes. Applications received after this date will NOT be considered.
- Late Spring 2023: Scholarship recipients will be notified

Applicant Checklist:

1. Online application (google form)
2. Transcript (copy/jpeg pictures okay)
3. Two letters of recommendation
 - a. PDF file
 - b. One must be written by an Art Teacher
4. 300-word Personal Essay that answers the following questions:
 - a. What role does art play in your life?

- b. Describe why you are applying for this scholarship. Include any unusual family, personal or economic circumstances or responsibilities associated with your family which will support this application
 - c. Why did you select the work you submitted for your Portfolio?
 - d. How do you hope people will react when they look at your work?
5. Movie presentation of artwork
- a. .MOV file
 - b. File should be named lastname_firstname_school.MOV
 - c. Suggested apps to create film are iMovie and Final Cut Pro, but comparable apps are okay
 - d. Movie should include:
 - i. Title Slide: your name and school in Arial or Times Roman Font on a neutral background (black or white).
 - ii. Second Slide: Please include a screenshot of your personal essay with a voice recording. The essay should be on a neutral background and you can record yourself reading it out loud.
 - iii. The next slides should showcase ten pieces of your top artwork. Each slide should contain only one image on a neutral background (Black, White or Grey) labeled with Name, Medium, Dimensions (Size) and Date of completion in Arial or Times New Roman Font. Please nicely crop each picture and have all information at the bottom of each picture. Optional: talk about each piece for up to 20 seconds.

Please review your entire submission prior to turning in your application. Incomplete applications or applications that do not follow the directions will not be reviewed.
