Scholarship Name: Frederick High School Booster Club Scholarship

Award: Three (3) awards of \$1,000 each

Background: The Frederick High School Booster Club is a parent run volunteer group, dedicated to the support of the student body, organizations, clubs, arts and athletic clubs at Frederick High School. Through volunteerism and fundraising, the Booster Club is able to provide these scholarships.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school senior at Frederick High School
- Have a 2.5 grade point average or higher
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at a **trade/vocational institution, two-year or four-year college/university** located in the United States beginning the fall of 2023.
- Have been active in at least 1 extra-curricular activity

Application Process:

Step 1: Complete the general scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation (SVVSEF) website (www.stvrainfoundation.org/scholarships). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Application Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, high school, GPA, high school transcript, graduation date and name of college, university or trade school the student will be attending.
- **Financial Need** including the EFC from the FAFSA, the FAFSA SAR report and one – two paragraphs explaining the students financial aid situation or financial need.
- **Volunteer and Community Service Record**
- **High School Honors and Awards**
- **High School Activities**
- **Leadership Positions**
- **Paid Work Experience** (if applicable)
- **Letters of Recommendation** to include one from a teacher, administrator or counselor and one from a community member who is not a family member.

Step 2: Complete the **Frederick High School Booster Club Scholarship** application via SVVSEF scholarship platform on Kaleidoscope.

- **Personal Questions** that are 100 words or less.
 - Please tell us about a time that you faced a challenge and a goal was not accomplished. What steps did you take to recover? How and why are you different today from that experience?
 - Describe a topic, special interest or experience that you find so engaging that you lose track of time. What have you done to learn more or grow from this favorite topic or activity.
 - How will receiving this scholarship allow you to further your educational goals?
