Henry Braly Football Lineman Scholarship

Award: One (1) award of \$10,000 to be paid over two years

- \$5,000 for first year or first half of trade school program and \$5,000 for second year or second half of trade school program
- For the second year of scholarship funding you will be required to provide:
 - Proof of continued enrollment
 - Proof of maintaining a 2.5 GPA or higher

Background: The Braly Family Foundation was established in 2006 in honor of Guy and Laura Braly. This scholarship is in honor of the foundation's founder Henry Braly. Henry was a lineman at Longmont High in the 1950's and continued to play in college.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school senior at a St. Vrain Valley Schools high school
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **trade school, two-year or four-year college or university** located in the United States, beginning the fall of 2023.
- Have a history of excellence as a Football Lineman
- Have a 2.5 grade point average or higher
- In an effort to be fair and to assist as many students as possible, students can only receive one of all available scholarships the Braly Family Foundation presents.

Application Process: Complete the online scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation (SVVSEF) website (www.stvrainfoundation.org/BralyScholarship). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Student Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, GPA, and name of trade school, college or university the student will be attending. In addition, parent(s) name and contact information.
- **Provide Required Document and Football Coaches Information**
 - High school transcript
 - Name, email and mobile phone number of a football coach who can provide a reference
- **Scholarship questionnaire answering the following questions:**
 1. What has playing football meant to you?
 2. What are your plans for your future education?
 3. Tell us about you (pick one): A Special Talent, Funny Story, Your Best Memory

Selection Process: A committee consisting of the representatives from the district athletic office (two votes) and the Braly Family Foundation Board (one vote) will select the scholarship recipient.

The Braly Family Foundation will provide dessert with the awarded applicant and their family. They would also like to highlight the scholarship recipient with a post on social media.
