



Scholarship Name: Kathy Hall Future Impact Scholarship

Award: One (1) award of \$2,000

Background: The Kathy Hall Future Impact Scholarship was developed to demonstrate the Education Foundation Board of Directors' appreciation for our past Executive Director, Kathy Hall. Kathy volunteered 9 years of service to the Education Foundation. Her passion for enhancing student success and teacher excellence helped the foundation to have significant growth during her tenure.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school senior at a St. Vrain Valley Schools high school.
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **trade/vocational institution, two-year or four-year college/university** located in the United States, beginning the fall of 2023.
- Have a 2.5 grade point average or higher.
- Be a student who is well-rounded.
- Be a student with financial need.

Application Process:

Step 1: Complete the online scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation website (www.stvrainfoundation.org/scholarships). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Application Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, high school, GPA, high school transcript, graduation date and name of college, university or trade school the student will be attending.
- **Financial Need** including the EFC from the FAFSA, the FAFSA SAR report and one – two paragraphs explaining the students financial aid situation or financial need.
- **Volunteer and Community Service Record**
- **High School Honors and Awards**
- **High School Activities**
- **Leadership Positions**
- **Paid Work Experience** (if applicable)
- **Letters of Recommendation** to include one from a teacher, administrator or counselor and one from a community member who is not a family member.

Step 2: Complete the **Kathy Hall Future Impact Scholarship** application via SVVSEF scholarship platform on Kaleidoscope.

- **Personal Essay** that is 500 words or less. This is your opportunity to tell the selection committee about yourself, the factors that have helped you become the person you are today and where you are planning to go in the future. The topic of the essay is *“How I Am Going to Make a Difference in My Community in the Future”*. Please make sure to include:
 - What you will do in the future to make a difference and have an impact in an area where your passion lies?
 - How you will make this happen?
 - How do you see it benefiting both you and your community, those around you or those in need, both now and in the future?
