Scholarship Name: Larry Sieckmann Memorial Scholarship

Award: One (1) awards of \$1,000

Background: Larry Sieckmann was a long-time community resident proudly involved in community banking and local civic organizations. He was vitally interested in making the Longmont and Mead area a great place to work and raise children. Larry's family and friends are honoring his memory with the scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a high school senior at Longmont High School or Mead High School.
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **two-year or four-year college or university** located in the United States, beginning the fall of 2022.

Application Process:

Step 1: Complete the online scholarship application on the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation website (www.stvrainfoundation.org). You will be required to submit the following information:

- **Application Information** to include name, address, phone number, email address, high school, GPA, high school transcript, graduation date and name of college, university or trade school the student will be attending.
- **Financial Need** including the EFC from the FAFSA, the FAFSA SAR report and one – two paragraphs explaining the students financial aid situation or financial need.
- **Volunteer and Community Service Record**
- **High School Honors and Awards**
- **High School Activities**
- **Leadership Positions**
- **Letters of Recommendation** to include one from a teacher, administrator or counselor and one from a community member who is not a family member.

Step 2: Complete the Larry Sieckmann Memorial Scholarship application via SVVSEF scholarship platform on Kaleidoscope.

- **Personal Essay** that is 500 words or less. This is your opportunity to tell the selection committee about yourself, the factors that have helped you become the person you are today and where you are planning to go in the future. The essay should describe why you would consider yourself to be a balanced, well-rounded person, why being one is important to you and how your future goals will help you remain this way. Be sure to include information about pertinent aspects of your life including academics, athletics and community that are important to you. What your current goals are for the future, both short-term and long-term.
