Michael Thomas Hoge Scholarship for Mathematics

Award: One (1) award of \$1,000 and two (2) awards of \$500 each

Background: Michael's family and friends fund this scholarship to honor Michael's thirst for knowledge, adventure, travel, and his love of playing Monopoly. This scholarship is intended to go to a driven, well rounded student, with a love of learning, math, and adventure.

To Be Eligible for Nomination, Students Must:

- Be a high school senior at Longmont High school
- Be planning to enroll as a full-time student at an accredited **two-year or four-year college, university or trade school** located in the United States, beginning the fall of 2022.
- Have a history of hard work and determination as identified by the faculty at Longmont High School.

Nomination Process: The Longmont High School counselors and faculty of the math department are asked to identify candidates for this scholarship. After candidates are identified a counselor or math department faculty member should complete and provide the following:

- **Scholarship Nomination Form** to include student name, address, phone number, email address, and name of college, university or trade school the student will be attending. In addition, counselor or faculty member contact information.
- **High School Transcript(s)**
- **One-Page Summary** about the student, detailing how he/she has demonstrated a history of hard work and determination, and why this student should be considered for the Michael Thomas Hoge Scholarship for Mathematics.

Selection Process: The Longmont High School selection committee will consider:

- Counselor or Faculty member's one-page nomination of the student, detailing how he/she has demonstrated a history of hard work and determination and why the student should be considered for this scholarship.
- High school transcript(s)
- Information about the student's college of choice, if it has been made
- Decision must be delivered to the St. Vrain Valley Schools Education Foundation no later than April 5, 2022.
